

### INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS

#### WORLD HEALTH ORGANISATION ABORTION **CARE GUIDELINES: LAW AND POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS**

- Recommend the full decriminalisation of abortion (accessing, providing, assisting).
- Recommend against laws that restrict abortion to specific grounds. Abortion should be available on request of the pregnant person.
- Recommend against laws or regulations that prohibit abortion based on
- Recommend against mandatory waiting periods for abortion.
- Recommend that abortion be available at the request of the pregnant person without the authorisation of any other individual, body, or institution (e.g., no parental, spousal, judicial authorisation).
- Recommend against regulations on who can provide or manage abortion that are inconsistent with WHO guidance.
- Recommend that access to and continuity of abortion care be protected against barriers created by conscientious objection

## OUNCIL OF EUROPE PARLIAMENTARY

- The lawfulness of abortion does not have an effect on a woman's need for an abortion, but only on her access to a safe abortion.
- The denial of abortion care may constitute torture or cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment, and it underlines the importance of the absolute prohibition of torture and other forms of cruel, inhuman o

### **SAFE ABORTION METHODS APPROVED BY WHO**

Manual or electric vacuum aspiration, or medical methods using a combination of mifepristone followed by misoprostol

### METHODS AFTER 12–14 WEEKS SINCE THE LMP:

- Surgical method: D&E, using vacuum aspiration and forceps.
- Medical method: for abortions after 12 weeks since the LMP is mifepristone followed by repeated doses of misoprostol

WHO recommends that individuals in the first trimester (up to 12 weeks pregnant) can self-administer mifepristone and misoprostol medication without direct supervision of a health-care provider.5
